

# POOL RULES

The lifeguard is the authority on the pool deck. His or her verbal commands take precedence in any situation and must be obeyed for your safety and the safety of others. Due to the nature of the environment and the difference of opinions with interpretations, the lifeguard has the final call with respect to any and all rules. Decisions may be challenged/argued after the fact to a higher level of authority but must be obeyed at the moment in time and without question. Failure to obey lifeguard instructions will result in loss of pool privileges which may include immediate removal from the facility.

No Running, horse playing, pushing, chicken fighting, etc.

Children wearing USCG approved life vests, may swim without an adult in the water. The parent/adult guardian must be on deck, inside the fence, in eyeshot and directly supervising the child.

Children wearing non-approved floatation devices (water wings specifically) must be in arms reach of the parent at all times while in the pool/baby pool.

Rafts, Inflatable floats, mats, boogie boards or similar items are prohibited in the pool. Supervised children under 3 within arm's reach of the parent/guardian may use the small ring floats or similar.

Children may not Pee on Deck or on the beach, please use rest rooms.

Parents must directly supervise children under 3 on the baby pool slide. Someone must be on deck to help the child up the ladder and one in the water to catch the child.

Wrist bands must be worn in plain sight on the wrist or bathing suit.

No glass in the facility

Appropriate bathing attire must be worn to use the pool. NO thongs, basketball shorts, street clothes, etc. T-shirts may be worn over swim suits. Babies must wear suits over swim diapers. Swim diapers or water pants must be worn by all non-potty trained children.

No changing Diapers or clothing on deck, table tops, or chairs. Please use the changing stations in the locker rooms.

This is a non-smoking Pool/Beach. Smoking area is on the BBCC Deck ONLY.

Balls, Frisbees or other throwable items are prohibited in the pool. Other toys may be used as long as they are not being thrown or disturbing other pool users. Lifeguards will make the call as to what is/ is not appropriate if there is a problem/question.

Breaks are every hour at quarter till the hour. Adults and adults with children under 3 with in arms reach may use the pool at this time. All others must exit the water.

No standing, sitting or walking on the wall between the baby pool and adult pool

No Flipping into the pool from the deck or diving into the shallow end

Diving Board Rules:

One person on the board at a time

No gainers, inward dives or similar

No jumping off the side of the board toward the wall, must jump straight off

One bounce

Children wearing USCG approved vests may use the board with direct parental supervision.

No diving through floats, throwing balls or other items to the diver

Slide Rules (Large slide exits into 10 feet of water)

Feet First ONLY

One person at a time

No jumping from the top of the slide structure

No loud music. The pool has a sound system in use

Rinse sand off before entering the pool
